



Laying Click Together Pavers

Laying Click Together Pavers – A step-by-step guide

1. Measure the area to be covered and calculate how many click together pavers are needed (you will need 0.09m² or 11 pavers per m²).
2. Gather together the equipment and tools you need for your project, including a tape measure, a safety retractable knife, screwdriver, knee pads and sealant (optional).
3. Clean your floor surface. The surface must be clean and free of dust or dirt. If it is a painted surface, remove flaky paint and sand to create a smooth surface.
4. Unpack and stack the pavers in your required area.
5. Begin laying pavers from one corner or a fixed object (e.g. House Wall). Take the first tile and move to the corner. Ideally you should start in the corner that is most apparent when entering the room or area. This ensures a row of full pavers (as opposed to cut to fit pavers) will be visible. Place the first paver in position and then lock the adjacent paver by pushing it down to engage the connecting tabs on the sides of each paver.
6. Continue adding pavers this way until the row is complete. You may be required to cut the final tile to fit the area. Once the first row is complete, move to the next row. Continue with this until the area is completely covered and all the pavers are securely locked in place to each adjacent paver.
7. To fit around pipes, posts or corners, just cut out the required shape from the paver and lock the pavers into place. No adhesives are needed.
8. To maintain the look and finish of these pavers, we recommend coating the pavers with a good quality sealant. Ensure you follow the manufacturer's instructions on the application of sealer.
